



## BACKBONE LOOP

*Backbone State Park is about midway in the tour loop. You might want to plan a side trip into the park for a picnic or to walk the "Backbone". You could also stop at Traver's Farm Toys, Quilt No. 12. The loop includes ten barn quilts, is about 36 miles long (10 miles of gravel road), and will take one hour to one and one-half hours without any side stops.*
