



ROBINSON - RYAN LOOP

From Manchester, head west on 220th St. to Robinson Road and down through the Ryan area, and back to Manchester for a Dairy Queen. The route has 13 barn quilts, is about 40 miles long (12 miles of gravel road) and will take one to one and one half hours to complete without side stops.
